



Financial Services Executives in the Classroom: December 6-12, 2009

Executives from member companies of The Financial Services Roundtable are hitting the classroom in December. As part of “Executives in the Classroom”, the executives are leading financial literacy sessions across the country. This week-long effort is part of the Roundtable's broader Community Service 2009 initiative, a year-round commitment that focuses on strengthening communities.

“Executives in the Classroom” will reaffirm this commitment through hands-on financial literacy sessions during the week of December 6. “Executives in the Classroom” will be spearheaded by Junior Achievement, but companies may participate with any non-profit organization.

All events will include significant interaction between executives and students following the themes of fiscal responsibility and responsible holiday spending.
