Definitions

Community Service: Community service involves services or activities volunteered by individuals from a member company to benefit a community (where they live and work), an institution or an organization.

Community Service Project: A volunteer project that provides a service or resource to a community.
Examples: One Habitat home build is one project. Sponsoring a blood drive at the office is one project. Providing tax preparation services over the course of one work week would count as five projects (one project/day).

Financial Education Project: A project in the community that focuses on teaching or promoting financial education. These projects can include seminars, classroom teaching, one-on-one mentoring sessions, etc.

Example: One Junior Achievement classroom session counts as one project. Therefore, classroom sessions that occur once a week for five weeks would together count as five projects.

Volunteer: A volunteer is counted as one employee who participates in a community service/financial literacy project.

People Served: The number of people helped or affected by the community service/financial education project.

Charitable Monies Raised: The amount of money used to support or sponsor a community service/financial education project.
