Workshops for unbanked/ underbanked:

These are offered in community settings – churches, non-profit agencies, senior centers, and etc.

Facilitators strive to be relational, non-judgmental, and easy to approach.

Workshops are 'bank neutral'. Specific bank products and services are not discussed, unless a participant approaches the facilitator with a specific question.

Workshops are interactive and lively.

The sessions feature conversations, group activities and role play games.

Participants receive a take-home handout with pertinent points, but very little reading and writing done in class.
