In 2010, Northern contributed \$14.2 million to nonprofit organizations globally. The majority of funds were directed to human service organizations, which provide critical services to low and moderate income families striving to build better lives. In addition to cash contributions, Northern Trust employees volunteer nearly 200,000 hours a year to charities globally.

One organization receiving support from Northern Trust staff is Chicago's Casa Central. Located in the Logan Square neighborhood, Casa Central transforms lives and strengthens communities with a special focus on Hispanics. Thirty employees visited Casa Central in mid-November to partner with its Head Start and School Age Youth Programs. These programs serve over 1,000 children annually and are growing year over year.
