**HPC Statement on Independent Foreclosure Review Deadline Extension**

WASHINGTON, DC –February 15, 2012—In response to the announcement from the OCC on the extension for eligible homeowners to file for an Independent Foreclosure Review, Paul Leonard, Senior Vice President of Government Affairs for the Housing Policy Council, issued the following statement.

“The primary goal for mortgage servicers involved in this process is to ensure that those who are eligible and want an independent review of their foreclosure case can get one. We fully support the extension of the deadline to give eligible homeowners additional time to examine their file and make a decision that best suits their individual situation.
