## **2011 Community Service Program at All-Time High** **Roundtable Reports 357,000 Projects**

WASHINGTON, DC –February 16, 2012—The member companies of The Financial Services Roundtable ended 2011 on a high note by increasing the total amount of community service projects by 18% from the previous year, just shy of 357,000 and the most ever recorded in the history of the Roundtable's program.

“At BBVA Compass, we work for a better future for people,” said Manolo Sanchez, president and CEO of BBVA Compass, and Chairman of Community Service 2012. “That work begins in the communities where we operate, with helping a child to read, teaching a young adult to balance a checkbook, or feeding a hungry family. We understand that our success as a universal bank is inherently tied to the success of others.”

“Community service is a pillar of the financial services industry,” said Steve Bartlett, president and CEO for the Roundtable. “The relationship between the communities and their financial institutions is symbiotic; customers depend on us to finance their future, and we in turn give back to enrich the community.”

The feeling proved true indeed for 2011, as Roundtable member companies increased the monies raised for community-related programs and projects by 26%, to a total of over \$442 million.

With a continued focus on financial literacy, companies also participated in 59% more financial literacy projects, with 45,610.
